

Troop 809 Tent Cleaning and Storage

The following procedures for the new Timberline tents taken home for cleaning are as follows:

1. Any tent should be cleaned and dried the day taken home or the next dry day (**but no longer than a couple days** as mildew will grow and permanently damage the tent)
2. Set the tent up and drape rainfly and ground cover separately over a clothes line.
3. When the tent is dry, clean the interior of debris.
4. Disassemble the tent
5. Place all poles and junction tubes in pole bag
6. Place stakes in stake bag
7. Place tent and rainfly on dry ground and fold until it matches the length of the pole bag
8. Place the pole bag and stake bag together at one end of the folded tent/rainfly
9. Roll tent and rainfly around the pole and stake bag
10. Place tent in tent bag
11. Ground cover is placed separately in tent bag.

Component List:

- Tent
- Rain Fly
- Ground Cover
- Poles (4)
- Spanner (Center Pole)
- Fly Rods (2)
- Junction Tubes (2)
- Stakes (8)
- Tent Bag
- Pole Bag
- Stake Bag

Make a list of missing items and/or damage to the tent on a tag attached to the tent bag.

Bring tent to the Quartermaster at the next Troop Meeting.
